

Junior Kindergarten Registration

Pre-Registration

The Pre-Registration Form is for families interested in enrolling their junior kindergarten-age student starting in the fall. Enrollment will be decided by the priority list below. If there is more interest than spaces, there will be a lottery at the end of pre-registration to determine final placement. This approach provides equal access for all those interested in the program.

Priority List:

- Students currently in the Little Adventurers Program that will be turning four years old by September 1, 2023
- Four-year-old students who reside in District 38
- Four-year-old students who do not reside in District 38

If AM and PM classes are full, students will be added to a waiting list.

Online Registration

If your student secures a space in the Junior Kindergarten program, families will be sent information on completing the online registration process. The online registration portal opens on the morning of December 5.

During online registration, you either need to:

- Make a non-refundable payment in full for the Junior Kindergarten tuition of \$6,000
- Make a non-refundable \$500 payment, and pay the remaining \$5,500 before Labor Day

If an opening becomes available, families on the waiting list will be contacted to see if they are still interested in registering their student.

Birth Certificate

Submit an original or certified birth certificate to the school office. A valid Passport is acceptable at the time of registration, a birth certificate must be submitted to the school within 30 days of the online registration form.

Complete the Family Information Form providing general information about the student and family for teachers. This form can be mailed or emailed (swhite@kenilworth38.org) to the school office.
